1. **Fredonia Interconnections** – Village Trustee Pacos reported that village attorney Gard has prepared an agreement between village and NCCWD to approve the two water main interconnections on the East and West side. At their next Village Board meeting he anticipates a resolution to authorize Mayor Essek to sign the agreement and then forward to NCCWD for final execution. Discussion ensued that NCCWD will need to have an agreement with Town of Pomfret to make the interconnections at Town of Pomfret water district mains (at Route 20 east and Route 20 west near Brocton).
